

Bobcat Skid Steer Safe Operating

Read and understand operators manual before use

- 1. Use 3 point contact when entering and exiting the machine.
- 2. Wear the seat belt and lower seat bar for restraint.
- 3. Never exceed the machines rated operator capacity.
- 4. Never use loader as a man lift or elevating device for personnel.
- 5. If you must work in an enclosed area, make sure there is adequate ventilation as exhaust fumes can be harmful.
- 6. Never carry riders, keep bystanders away from work area.
- 7. Always carry bucket or attachments as low as possible. Do not travel or turn with arms up. Load, unload and turn on flat level ground.
- 8. Never leave the loader with the engine running or with the lift arms up. To park, engage the parking brake and put attachments flat on the ground.
- 9. Wear proper clothing and use personal protection equipment as required for the job.
- 10. Call local utilities before you dig: 1-888-258-0808
 - Know the location of underground gas, water and electrical lines.
- 11. On slopes, keep heavy end uphill and never go across them.
- 12. Keep hands and feet on controls or footrests. Never lean out the front of the cab with the engine running.
